Entrance Dates:

Admissions Criteria:

- Submit a completed application and nonrefundable application fee;
- Must be at least 16 years of age;
- Official copies of your high school transcript verifying graduation or GED passing scores must be on file in the Admissions Office in order to graduate from the program;
- Submit official copies of any postsecondary transcripts to the Admissions Office;
- Take the HGTC placement exam or provide comparable SAT, ACT, or CPE scores in English, reading and math;
- Attend New Student Orientation
- Must have successfully completed the Flat Shielded Metal Arc Welder technical certificate of credit program.
